Dear Village Ringer Audition Candidate,

I'm so pleased of your interest in *Village Ringers*. We strive to be an EXCELLENT group of handbell professionals. We work hard at our rehearsals, but have fun at the same time.

Our by-laws state our purpose as follows:

The objectives of Village Ringers are to:

- Attract and challenge intermediate to advanced handbell ringers through the rehearsal and performance of quality music.
- To expand the public appreciation of and interest in handbell music through engaging performances.
- To provide education to the greater community on the art of handbell ringing.
- To encourage public appreciation of and interest in handbell music.
- To have fun!

Your audition for the 2026 Spring season will take place at 10:00 on Monday, January 5 at New Covenant United Methodist Church (3470 Woodridge Dr.) This is the same location where our weekly rehearsals are held – each Monday from 1:00-3:00 pm. When you enter the church, please look for the <u>playground</u> and enter in the door beside the playground. Walk straight down the hall and you will find us!

Please understand that EVERY person – both current members, and those auditioning for a position – are "on trial." Prior membership does not guarantee a position.

This is what you can expect on your audition day: There will be some simple warmup exercises, then you'll be asked to sight-read at least 3 pieces. The selections will be portions of actual pieces we'll be performing in our Christmas concert. Initially, I'll try to place you in your preferred position, or as close as I can get. You'll play one of the pieces in at least 2 different positions – perhaps even reading both bass and treble clef. Remember that, occasionally, you are called on to play in different positions in *Village Ringers*, and it's important that you're willing to challenge yourself in this way.

The audition will last about 45 minutes. You will then be dismissed. You will be notified by email, prior to 12:00 noon, of your status. The first rehearsal will then begin at 1:00 on the same day.

I strongly encourage you to check the box in the Village Ringer's Contract that you are willing to serve as a substitute. We find ourselves regularly in need of subs, and this helps to give you an "in-road" of experience and exposure for the Village Ringers. Occasionally, we also lose a player due to illness or some other circumstance, at which time you may be called to be a permanent sub.

Village Ringers has two main concerts – a Christmas Concert and a Spring Concert. Specific dates to be determined. There are occasional ringing opportunities that present themselves, but agreed on by the entire group prior to acceptance. Rehearsals take place each Monday from 1:00-3:00 at New Covenant United Methodist Church. Rehearsals begin the second Monday in September through the December concert, and January through the

April concert. You are expected to be at all rehearsals.

I'm excited for the audition process, and I look forward to putting together a terrific team of musicians! In the meantime, if you have any questions or concerns, don't hesitate to contact me at bonniefisher53@gmail.com or 614-565-0953.

	1. Members will be selected by an impartial judge(s), along with a majority vote of the handbell ringer members of the Board, based on auditions, which will be held at least once per year. Board decisions on membership are final and not subject to any appeal authority.
	2. Membership is open to all qualified handbell ringers. All prospective members are required to audition annually for membership.
	3. Members are to be Village Residents however, up to five (5) members may be non-residents. You must be able to faithfully attend rehearsals currently being held each Monday at New Covenant United Methodist Church located at 3470 Woodridge Dr., from 1:00-3:00 pm. Our winter/Christmas "segment" is from the 2 nd Monday in September through the 2 nd week in December. The spring "segment" is from the first Monday in January through the 2 nd or 3 rd week in April.
	4. Persons will be admitted to membership if they meet the criteria established by the Music Director and/or Executive Committee. Failure to continue to demonstrate an adequate skill level shall be grounds for dismissal. New members will be accepted after auditions are held each concert period (dates to be determined) or when positions become available.
	5. The Secretary of Village Ringers will keep a record of attendance. Attendance for all rehearsals and performances is mandatory unless prior agreement has been approved by the Music Director. Excessive absences during the season will be grounds for dismissal. The Music Director must be notified of anticipated absences. Substitutes for performances or rehearsals may be made at the discretion of the Music Director and/or Board.
	6. All members are expected to arrive early to rehearsals and performances in order to assist in setup and to be in position to ring at the scheduled start time. Excessive tardiness shall be grounds for dismissal.
