

Village Ringers Audition Packet for the 2026-2027 Year

Dear *Village Ringer* Audition Candidate,

I'm so pleased of your interest in *Village Ringers*. We strive to be an EXCELLENT group of handbell professionals. We work hard at our rehearsals, but have fun at the same time.

Our by-laws state our purpose as follows:

The objectives of the *Village Ringers* are to:

- Attract and challenge intermediate to advanced handbell ringers through the rehearsal and performance of quality music.
- Encourage public appreciation of and interest in handbell music through engaging performances and other activities.
- Provide education to the greater community on the art of handbell ringing.
- Have fun!

In order to audition you must complete an Audition Application. You can access that electronic form from a link on the Membership page or directly at this address: www.villageringers.com/audition-application-eform

Your audition for the 2026 Christmas season will take place at 10:00 am on Monday, September 14th at New Covenant United Methodist Church (3470 Woodridge Dr.) This is the same location where our weekly rehearsals are held – each Monday from 1:00-3:00 pm. You are encouraged to park in the back of the church (East parking lot). Enter the door at the far right side (there are picnic benches and tables under a roof). This door will take you directly into the choir room, where rehearsals are held.

Please understand that EVERY person – both current members, and those auditioning for a position – are “on trial.” Prior membership does not guarantee a position.

This is what you can expect on your audition day: There will be some simple warmup exercises, then you'll be asked to sight-read at least 3 pieces. The selections will be portions of actual pieces we'll be performing in our Christmas concert. Initially, I'll try to place you in your preferred position, or as close as I can get. You'll play one of the pieces in at least 2 different positions – perhaps even reading both bass and treble clef. Remember that, occasionally, you are called on to play in different

positions in ***Village Ringers***, and it's important that you're willing to challenge yourself in this way.

Other areas on which you will be judged include your ability to sight-read; control of your bell/circular motion; knowledge and use of special techniques such as mart, echo, and mallets; performance presence – looking up, smiling, confidence, etc.

The audition will last about 45 minutes. You will then be dismissed. You will be notified by email, prior to 12:00 noon, of your status. The first rehearsal will begin at 1:00 on the same day.

I strongly encourage you to check the box in the Village Ringer's Contract that you are willing to serve as a substitute. We find ourselves regularly in need of subs, and this helps to give you an "in-road" of experience and exposure for the Village Ringers. Occasionally, we also lose a player due to illness or some other circumstance, at which time you may be called to be a permanent sub.

Village Ringers hold two main concerts – a Christmas Concert – this year on Tuesday, December 8, 2026 at 7:00 pm - and a Spring Concert on Tuesday, April 14, 2027 at 7:00 pm. There are occasional ringing opportunities that present themselves, but agreed on by the entire group prior to acceptance. Rehearsals take place each Monday from 1:00-3:00 at New Covenant United Methodist Church. You are expected to attend all rehearsals.

I'm excited for the audition process, and I look forward to putting together a terrific team of musicians! In the meantime, if you have any questions or concerns, don't hesitate to contact me at or 614-565-0953.

Audition Requirements and Member Contract

I, _____, am auditioning for a position in the *Village Ringers* handbell ensemble.

- **Auditions to become a Village Ringer will take place (usually) the 2nd Monday of January and the 2nd Monday of September of each calendar year. At least 6 weeks of advance notice will be published via email, Facebook, and the Village Ringers website of the audition date and time.**
- **Every candidate is required to audition each time. However, if a candidate is absolutely unable to make the audition, and is a previous ringer with Village Ringers, then the results from their last audition will be considered in making final selections. Permission from the Music Director must be received in order to qualify for this exemption.**

All new candidates are required to audition.

Please initial each item below to indicate your agreement to the following membership rules as set forth by the Village Ringers, Inc. By-Laws, Article 3:

- _____ 1. Members will be selected by the Music Director, along with a majority vote of the handbell ringer members of the Board, based on auditions. Board decisions on membership are final and not subject to any appeal authority.
- _____ 2. Membership is open to all qualified handbell ringers. All prospective members are required to audition in January and September of each calendar year for membership.
- _____ 3. Members must be Village Residents and shall faithfully attend rehearsals currently being held each Monday at New Covenant United Methodist Church located at 3470 Woodridge Dr., from 1:00-3:00 pm. Our winter/Christmas “segment” is from the 2nd Monday in September through the 2nd week in December. The spring “segment” is from the first or second Monday in January through the 2nd or 3rd week in April.
- _____ 4. Persons will be admitted to membership if they meet the criteria established by the Music Director and/or Executive Committee. Failure to continue to demonstrate an adequate skill level shall be grounds for dismissal. New members will be accepted after auditions or when positions become available.
